- Register with HP iPAQ Navigate to access the free trip planning service.
- Create a trip itinerary directly on iPAQ Navigate. Include details, such as travel dates, arrival and departure locations and length of stay.
- Add as many points of interests as desired – search online for countless restaurants, hotels and attractions right from the iPAQ Navigate website and add to or edit the itinerary.
- When trip plans are complete, download plans onto HP iPAQ 300 Series Travel Companion.
- If trip plans change along the way, edit itineraries directly on the HP iPAQ 300 Series Travel Companion and instantly share updates with others, by simply logging back onto www.ipaq.com/navigate.
- When logging back into the site, travelers can also add notes about great

restaurants, shortcuts to destinations and the best hotels from their trip so that others can use the existing itinerary to create their own custom trip plans.
