Aurelio Maruggi is general manager of Inkjet High-Speed Production Solutions within the Imaging and Printing Group at HP. He and his team are responsible for the development of a new category of high-volume digital presses based on inkjet technology and the deployment of end-to-end solutions to accelerate the adoption of digital printing in the publishing and mailstream segments.

Based in San Diego, Maruggi joined HP in December 2002 to manage IPG Strategic Alliances. In 2005, his role expanded to include Original Equipment Manufacturer Business Development, Operations and Sales of HP products and inkjet technology.

Prior to HP, Maruggi served in various technical roles with Olivetti, including a position as the program manager responsible for the development of the first Olivetti inkjet printer. He later acted as vice president of the Olivetti Inkjet division and then as general manager of Jotech, a joint venture between Olivetti Lexikon and Philips, in which he was chartered to develop fax and internet appliances for the European market.

Maruggi co-founded Yminds S.A. in Switzerland, an engineering firm specializing in advanced micromechanics and color science, and he has served as director of the board of Olivetti I-Jet S.p.A., Jotech S.p.A. and Yminds S.A.

A native of Italy, Maruggi holds a master's degree in electrical engineering from the University of Padova.
