Automatic calibrations ensure that the printer is always ready and smart media sensing ensures media is loaded precisely. Additionally, this printer series eliminates any need to clean the printheads manually, ensuring that the printer is always ready to print.

HP Designjet 788 inks and variable drop-size printheads combine to produce a greater image detail and smoother color transitions across a wide variety of media – such as banner vinyl, adhesive vinyl, canvas, paper and backlit film or rigid material up to 1 inch thick. Outdoor prints produced with HP Designjet 788 inks achieve display permanence up to three years outdoors, unlaminated.⁽¹⁾
