Pete Karolczak is senior vice president and general manager for Infrastructure Technology Outsourcing (ITO) within HP Enterprise Services.

Karolczak has responsibility for the overall ITO business, including business strategy, development and management of a world-class portfolio of services and capabilities, and requisite go-to-market strategies. The ITO business includes services spanning enterprise cloud, data center, workplace, network, security, transformation services and enterprise service management.

Previously, Karolczak was vice president of HP's IT Infrastructure and Operations, where he was responsible for core infrastructure (compute, storage and HP data centers) and end-user services (collaboration, client computing, print, access and mobility) as well as global application, infrastructure and site operations. In this role, he led a dramatic transformation of global infrastructure into a consolidated and highly standardized set of next-generation data centers.

Karolczak has held a variety of executive positions during his 23-year career at HP. As HP Services Client Executive, he was accountable for managing the business relationship and delivery commitments across all HP businesses and functions.

Immediately following the HP and Compaq merger, Karolczak led the IT Integration Office. He also was vice president and chief information officer for HP's Consumer Business as well as CIO for HP's Inkjet Imaging Systems.

Karolczak received a bachelor's degree in mathematics and computer science from Stanford University.
