Before joining HP in 2006, he was CEO of Oracle France where he was responsible for a number of strategic growth projects including the merger of Oracle and PeopleSoft and the acquisition of Siebel. Prior to this, he was vice president, Consulting and Systems Integration at Atos with responsibility for Southern Europe, Africa and the Middle East.

A French national, de Talhouët attended the Ecole Polytechnique and graduated with a Master of Sciences in telecommunications from the Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Télécommunications. He later completed his MBA at the Institut des Sciences Politiques, Paris.
